SAMPLE DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Día 1, Lunes 07 de Octubre: Salida hacia Estambul

Dirígete al aeropuerto donde abordarás tu vuelo nocturno. Las comidas se sirven a bordo.

Día 2, martes 08 de Octubre: Llegada a Estambul

Al llegar al aeropuerto de Estambul, encontrarás su equipaje y saldrá de la zona de recogida de equipaje en la sala de llegadas donde será recibido por nuestro guía turístico y/o conductor. Será trasladado a su hotel en Estambul. Esta noche disfrutarás de la cena de bienvenida y tendrá una noche de descanso.

Día 3, Miércoles 09 de Octubre: Estambul

Después del desayuno comenzamos nuestra visita guiada de día completo explorando esta antigua ciudad, incluyendo el magnífico Palacio Topkapi (principal residencia de los sultanes otomanos) y el Hipódromo bizantino que fue el escenario de las carreras de carros. A la vuelta de la esquina visitaremos la Basílica de Santa Sofía, sede histórica de la iglesia bizantina, construida en 360 d.C. y ahora un museo cuyos mosaicos, vitrales y cúpulas decoradas han sido diseñados para crear un entorno de belleza impresionante. Disfrute de un breve paseo por los jardines y proceda a la Mezquita Azul del sultán Ahmet I construida en 1616, famosa por sus incomparables azulejos de cerámica. Continúe con la visita a la Torre Galata y el Puente. En el distrito de Galata se encuentran muchas iglesias católicas. Visitaremos la Basílica de San Antonio de Padua, la iglesia católica más prestigiosa de Estambul, originalmente construida en este lugar en 1725, pero fue demolida a principios del siglo XX para dar paso a un tranvía. La iglesia fue reconstruida por el arquitecto Giulio Mongeri y terminada en 1912. Celebrar misa y visitar la Iglesia de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes, una parroquia histórica de la Iglesia Católica Griega Georgiana en el distrito de Bomonti del distrito de Şişli de Estambul. También nos detendremos en SS Pedro y Pablo es una iglesia católica en Estambul, importante por razones históricas. La iglesia posee una imagen de la Virgen del tipo Hodegetria, que originalmente se encontraba en una iglesia dominicana en Caffa, Crimea. Terminando nuestro día con una visita al Gran Bazar cubierto, un laberinto de calles y tiendas con la aroma y los sonidos de la vieja Turquía. Cena y alojamiento en Estambul.

Día 4, Jueves 10 de Octubre: Estambul - Adana vía Antioquía

Después del desayuno, salga del hotel para un vuelo doméstico temprano a la ciudad de Antioquía, la antigua Antioquía donde los cristianos fueron nombrados por primera vez y donde San Pablo comenzó sus viajes misioneros. Visitaremos la Cueva de San Pedro y el Museo de Mosaicos. Después del almuerzo, continuaremos hacia Seleucia Pieria (hoy conocida como Samandag), donde San Pablo y San Bernabé zarparon hacia Chipre en su primer viaje misionero. Desde allí regresamos a Adana para nuestra cena y alojamiento.

Día 5, Viernes, 11 de Octubre: Adana y Tarso - Capadocia

Después del desayuno, nos dirigiremos a Tarso, la ciudad natal de San Pablo, donde veremos los arcos de San Pablo y Cleopatra. Desde allí, continuaremos hacia Capadocia. El grupo tendrá almuerzo en ruta, cena y alojamiento en Capadocia.

Día 6, Sábado, 12 de Octubre: Capadocia

Hoy pasamos un día completo explorando la fascinante región de Capadocia. Visitamos el Valle de Göreme con sus iglesias trogloditas, exploramos la ciudad subterránea de Derinkuyu, vemos los conos de roca, visitamos Zelve y Avanos con sus complejos monásticos de conos rojos y Kaymaklı y sus ciudades subterráneas e iglesias. Estas capillas albergan algunas de las mejores pinturas murales conservadas a nivel mundial, que incluyen hermosas representaciones de la mitología cristiana. El grupo tendrá almuerzo durante las exploraciones y continuará con la visita a los valles de Pasabag y Pigeon para tener una vista de los impresionantes chimeneas de hadas responsables de la fama mundial de Capadocia. También disfrutará de una vista panorámica del castillo de Uchisar antes de regresar al hotel para cenar y pasar la noche en Capadocia.

Día 7, Domingo, 13 de Octubre: Capadocia - Konya - Antioquía de Pisidia - Antalya

Después del desayuno, nos dirigiremos a Konya (antigua Iconium), una ciudad en la que San Pablo y San Bernabé utilizaban la sinagoga como foro. Luego visitaremos el complejo museístico de los Derviches Girantes, que también es el lugar del Mausoleo de Mevlana (Rumi).

Después del almuerzo, nos dirigiremos a Antioquía de Pisidia, la ciudad donde San Pablo predicó su primer sermón registrado y fue expulsado más tarde. Entre las ruinas también visitamos los restos de dos basílicas. Continuamos conduciendo hacia el oeste, y finalmente llegamos a Antalya (Attalia) para cenar y nuestro hogar por 2 noches.

Día 8, Lunes, 14 de Octubre: Antalya

Saldremos del hotel para visitar el punto culminante de Antalya, el Museo de Arqueología, uno de los museos más finos y ricos del país, lleno de piezas de arqueología y etnografía de la costa mediterránea. Luego conduciremos brevemente a la ciudad de Aksu para visitar la antigua ciudad de Perge, una ciudad helenística reconstruida, con un maravilloso plan urbano, baños, templos y teatros; un lugar de predicación de Pablo. Luego continuamos hacia la antigua ciudad de Aspendos, una vez importante ciudad de Pamphylia, la Tierra de todas las Tribus. Cena y alojamiento en el hotel.

Día 9, Martes, 15 de Octubre: Antalya - Pamukkale

Por la mañana nos dirigiremos a Colosas (famosa por la carta de San Pablo a los Colosenses) para ver las paredes bizantinas y las otras ruinas restantes del sitio. Después del almuerzo continuamos hacia Laodicea, una de las "Siete Iglesias", donde visitamos el Odeón, el teatro y el gimnasio. Continuamos nuestro camino hacia nuestro hotel en Pamukkale (Hierápolis) donde cenamos y pasamos la noche.

Día 10, Miércoles, 16 de Octubre: Pamukkale - Kusadasi

Después del desayuno, visitamos Hierápolis con su necrópolis, baños, teatro y el lugar del martirio de San Felipe. Continuamos hacia Filadelfia, la ciudad del amor fraternal, fundada durante el reinado de Attalo II y una ciudad que también fue el sitio de una de las Siete Iglesias de la Revelación. Nuestro viaje nos lleva a Thyateira, otra de las Siete Iglesias. Según las cartas, los miembros de esta iglesia fueron elogiados por su firmeza contra el libertinaje. Después del almuerzo continuamos hacia Sardis, la capital de la antigua Lidia que también fue una de las Siete Iglesias Hermanas y un centro de importancia para varios grupos religiosos. Aquí, visitamos el templo de Cibeles y Diana (que más tarde se convirtió en una iglesia), la hermosa sinagoga y el gimnasio. Continuamos a Kusadasi para cenar y pasar la noche.

Día 11, Jueves, 17 de Octubre: Kusadasi - Éfeso - Mileto - Kusadasi

Después del desayuno visitamos las extensas ruinas de Éfeso, una de las Siete Iglesias. Aquí visitamos el teatro donde San Pablo predicó a los efesios, la biblioteca, el Odeón, la Iglesia Doble donde se celebró el Tercer Concilio Ecuménico en 431, y la Vía Mármol. Abandonamos las ruinas de la ciudad para visitar la Basílica de San Juan y la cercana Casa de la Virgen María. Después del almuerzo continuamos hacia Mileto, una de las principales ciudades jónicas y la patria de Tales, una ciudad que fue visitada dos veces por San Pablo. Aquí visitamos el teatro muy bien conservado, la Fortaleza Bizantina, el Delphinion, el Nymphaeion, el Bouleuterium y las Termas de Faustina. Regresamos a Kusadasi para cenar y pasar la noche.

Día 12, Viernes, 18 de Octubre: Kusadasi - Çanakkale

Salimos del hotel para dirigirnos al norte a lo largo de la costa del Egeo hasta la ciudad de Bergama para visitar la acrópolis y el Asclepeion de la ciudad helenística de Pérgamo. Cena y alojamiento en el hotel de Çanakkale.

Día 13, sábado 19 de octubre: Çanakkale - Troya - Estambul

Disfrute de una visita matutina a la antigua ciudad de Troya, el sitio de la mítica batalla de Troya. Después de explorar las ruinas, tome un ferry a través de los Dardanelos, marcando el final de su viaje. Luego, regrese a Estambul, donde cenará y pasará la noche.

Día 14, domingo 20 de octubre: Estambul - EE. UU.

Después de un desayuno temprano y unas sinceras despedidas, traslado al aeropuerto de Estambul para tomar el vuelo de regreso a casa.
